WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, James K. Jones, Charles H. Merillat, Charles J. Kappler and Fayette B. Dow, all citizens of the United States, and a majority of whom are residents of the District of Columbia, do, by these presents, pursuant to and in conformity with the provisions of Sub-chapter three of Chapter Eighteen of the Code of Laws for the District of Columbia, enacted March 3, 1905, and as subsequently amended, associate ourselves together as a body politic and corporate, for mutual improvement, and do hereby certify in writing:

FIRST: The name by which the corporation shall be known is AMERICAN PETROLEUM INSTITUTE.

SECOND: The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

THIRD: The particular business and objects of the corporation are, in all lawful ways:

- (a) To afford a means of co-operation with the Government in all matters of national concern; and
- (b) To foster foreign and domestic trade in American petroleum products; and
- (c) To promote in general the interests of the petroleum industry in all its branches; and
- (d) To promote the mutual improvement of its members and the study of the arts and sciences connected with the petroleum industry.

FOURTH: The number of directors who shall manage the corporation for the first year is thirty-five.
